## Coşkun Çörüz



Coşkun was a Member of the Dutch Parliament from 2001 until 2012. As a Member of Parliament Coşkun was the spokesperson on Safety and Justice, Information and Communication Technology, National Police, Youth Care and Youth Crime and also International Law and Human Rights. In that context, Coşkun was the Dutch Head of the Delegation to the Organisation for Security and Co-operation in Europe (OSCE) and also the Human Rights Rapporteur at the OSCE.

Coşkun is the Director of the International Child Abduction Center in the Netherlands (Center IKO) and a Member of the Transition Youth Authority. In May 2015, he became a Member of the Board of Directors of Missing Children Europe.

After his retirement from the Dutch Parliament, Coşkun became a consultant at Corendon Dutch Airlines. Prior to being a Member of the Dutch Parliament, Coşkun worked at the Dutch Center for Foreigners (NCB) in Amsterdam, was a Municipal Councillor in Haarlem, lecturer in Japan and a Commissioner at the Dutch Equal Treatment Commission (CGB).
