## REGISTRATION AND CANCELLATION POLICY

1. The number of participants is strictly limited. Approved registrations will be accepted on a first-come-first-serve basis.
2. Due to European Commission regulations, the number of "local" participants (participants travelling less than 100 km from the location of the event) is also limited.
3. Due to European Commission regulations, participants from the United Kingdom, Denmark and non-EU countries are not subject to discounts that may apply to Standard Participants and Webinar Participants (see above).
4. The registration is legally binding and can only be cancelled in accordance with the conditions outlined below.
5. Registrations may be submitted prior to 16<sup>th</sup> January 2017 or until the maximum number of participants has been reached. This shall not affect the cancellation conditions (see below).
6. A list of participants including each participant's address will be made available to all participants unless LEPCA receives a written objection from the participant no later than one week prior to the beginning of the event.
7. A certificate of attendance will be issued to each participant.
8. The participant should pay the registration fee within 10 days of registration by means of a bank transfer. In all cases LEPCA will send the participant an invoice beforehand. Participation will not be possible without prior payment.
9. The registration fee includes the blended training conference attendance and documentation as well as lunch and beverages during the event. An optional conference networking dinner will be held at Harnack-Haus on the Thursday evening, 26<sup>th</sup> January. Separate registration is required for the sponsored dinner (Please note that drinks are at participants' own expense). Please see above.
10. The participant must cover his/her own travel and accommodation expenses.
11. LEPCA reserves the right to cancel the event up to two weeks before the planned start. In this case, all registration fees received will be fully reimbursed. LEPCA will not be liable for any further damage caused by the cancellation.
12. LEPCA reserves the right to change the programme, including but not limited to the speakers, topics and allocated times. In the unlikely event that any foreseen speaker or workshop leader is unable to attend the Blended Training Conference, LEPCA will do its best to find a suitable replacement.

15. Cancellations received less than two weeks before the event (from 13:00 CET on 12<sup>th</sup> January 2017), 100% of the registration fee will be charged.
